

2009 Dates and Fees

(5 January - 11 December)



**Main Starting Dates: January 5, March 23, June 15, June 29,
July 6, July 27, August 24, September 21**

- Alternative starting dates: Students can start any Monday except March 16 or June 8
- Students cannot finish their course on March 27 or on September 25
- Elementary students must start their course on a main starting date
- Minimum period of enrolment : 2 weeks
- Public holidays: April 10, 13, May 4, 25, August 31. The school is closed on these dates, however a free excursion/activity is arranged.

Courses

All courses include a minimum of 28 lessons per week (21 hours) + daily homework + 2 hours' conversation club + 4 hours' supervised self-study (optional).

General English Course

Includes grammar, pronunciation, listening, speaking, reading and writing. If your level is upper-intermediate or above, you can choose an elective in Business English, British Life and Culture or Conversation on two afternoons per week.

IELTS Course (preparation for University entrance)

For upper-intermediate level and above. Includes General English (mornings) and IELTS preparation (afternoons).
