

# 2012 DATES & FEES

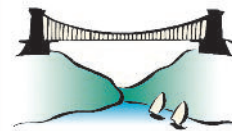
(3 January – 21 December)

## Main Starting Dates:

3 January, 19 March, 11 June, 9 July, 30 July, 28 August, 17 September

- No total beginners
- Elementary students must start their course on a main starting date
- Other students can start any Monday
- Students cannot finish their course on 23 March or on 21 September
- Minimum period of enrolment: 2 weeks
- Public holidays: 6, 9 April, 7 May, 4, 5 June, 27 August. The school is closed on these dates, however a free excursion/activity is usually arranged.

## COURSES

All courses include a minimum of 28 lessons per week (21 hours) + daily homework + 2 hours' conversation club + 4 hours' supervised self-study (optional).

### General English Course

Includes grammar, pronunciation, listening, speaking, reading and writing. If your level of English is B2 (upper-intermediate level) or above, on 2 afternoons a week, you can choose from a range of electives including Business English, British Life and Culture and Conversation.

### IELTS preparation/Academic English

For B2 (upper-intermediate level) and above.

Minimum period of enrolment: 4 weeks

Includes 18 hours of IELTS preparation/Academic English and 3 hours of electives.

### Cambridge Examination preparation

**FCE, CPE:** 3 January - 9 March (10 weeks)

**CAE:** 3 January - 16 March (11 weeks)

**FCE, CAE, CPE:** 19 March - 8 June (12 weeks\*)

**FCE, CAE:** 11 June - 24 August (11 weeks)

**FCE, CAE, CPE:** 17 September - 7 December (12 weeks)

\* In June 2012 the Cambridge English exams are held in the week after the end of the course, so students should book an extra week's accommodation (if required).

### Combination Course

Includes the same conditions as the General English Course + students have an additional 6 hours per week private tuition. Price: Normal tuition fees + £300.00 per week supplement. No Combination Courses in July and August.
